Notes

Last known complete table published in the Barnsley Chronicle 17 March 1896. On 06 July 1895 South Kirkby were formally accepted into Division One. On the 24 August Monk Bretton, who had been accepted, were officially withdrawn and were replaced by Barnsley Amateurs. The Barnsley Minor Cup was a league format competition, run by the Barnsley Association Football Union (established in 1893), formerly the Barnsley Charity Association. In the 1894/95 season there were two divisions. Swinton Town appear to have won Division One, though no final table was ever published. At the end of the 1895/96 season it was decided that the Barnsley Association Football Union would only run two competitions, not three. Player records are incomplete, unless specifically stated.
